2021 CONSERVATION POSTER CONTEST RULES

***DUE WED., APRIL 28 ***

- The 2021 theme, "HEALTHY FORESTS, HEALTHY COMMUNITIES" must be listed on the front of the poster along with the artwork.
- Student's NAME, GRADE, TEACHER must be the image file name OR listed in the email.
- must create your own poster, no groups/teams.
- Any media may be used to create a flat or two-dimensional flat effect (paint, crayon, colored pencils, charcoal, paper, etc.) No three dimensional effects: Styrofoam peanuts, real tree twigs, gravel, etc.)
- must be between 8.5" x 11' and 22" x 28".
- neat and easily read from a distance.
- One entry per person.
- judged at the county level, then entered for state level competition. Only one entry in each category (Kinder, 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th) will be forwarded to state level.
